

OUR 57th ENCAMPMENT

Wilson Burton will serve as Camp Manager for 2012. Serving with him are weekly directors, teachers, counselors, education directors, athletic directors, canteen directors, and other personnel needed to provide safe, healthful conditions and worthwhile activities. Adult counselors live in the cabins and are responsible for the campers.

Bible teaching and religious services are the center of Carolina Bible Camp. Our goal is to teach and demonstrate Christian principles and living. Each camper will have Bible and singing classes each day. There will be a worship service each Sunday evening. Campers will have devotional and worship opportunities throughout each day at camp.

Recreation is provided for each camper in the afternoon and each camper must participate in some kind of activity. A choice of many games, sports, handcrafts and other activities is offered. The selection in handcrafts is varied. There is a charge for handcraft materials. Prices range from 25¢ to \$10. Lifeguards are on duty at all swim periods. Boys and girls swim at different times.

Awards are given for excellence in sports and crafts. Mr. and Miss CBC will be selected each week. This is an honor every camper should seek. Director, Senior Camper, Staff, and Sports Awards are also awarded each week of camp.

Care should be taken with camp property at all times by staff and campers alike. Campers and staff are liable for any property damage inflicted by them as a result of intentional vandalism, negligence, or horseplay.

Modesty and good behavior are a basic in a Christian camp. A robe must be worn over swimsuits while campers go to and from the pool area. (Facilities are available at the pool for changing and showering.) Halters, short skirts, body shirts, clothing exposing the midriff, or any clothing determined to be immodest cannot be worn in camp. Boys do not go without shirts. Tank shirts cannot be worn by boys or girls. Shorts of a modest length may be worn by campers and staff. *Test of acceptable length: Standing with arms and hands down by side, shorts must reach tip of longest finger.*

Directions to CBC and Retreat Center

Take I-40 to US Hwy. 64, (Exit 168). Exit South on Hwy. 64 approximately 1/2 mile. Turn right on Greenhill Rd. Proceed to stop sign at Davie Academy Rd. Turn left and proceed 1/2 mile to Camp entrance on the left (just beyond Jericho Road Church of Christ meeting house).

Check in between 1:30pm and 5:30pm on Sunday. Please call the camp to let us know if you will be arriving late. Campers are to be picked up between 10:00am and 11:00am on Saturday.

Complete all of the application and send it along with a \$25 non-refundable deposit before June 1, 2012 to Wilson Burton. Make checks out to CBC.

Registrations are accepted on a “first come, first served” basis. When the quota for campers is full, registrants will be placed on a waiting list. Those placed on waiting lists will be notified of their position. No confirmation cards will be sent. You may check the CBC web page for additional detail as well as to confirm registration.

WHAT TO BRING:

Bring a Bible, notebook and pencil, a sleeping bag (or sheets and blanket), pillow, towels, jacket, swimsuit, sneakers, toilet articles (soap, toothbrush, comb, etc.), flashlight, musical instruments (if desired), and sports equipment. Make sure all items are carefully identified. Bring money for handcrafts and the canteen. All pricing is competitive.



WHAT NOT TO BRING:

Do not bring food! Any snack food brought to camp will be taken on Sunday and returned to the camper on Saturday. Any food brought for medically-mandated special diets is to be kept in the kitchen, under oversight of the Kitchen Director.

Do not bring radios/2-way radios/TVs/tape players/MP3 Players/CD Players/cell phones/etc.

Do not bring cigarettes, matches, fireworks, knives, or pets of any kind.

Medication should be labeled with the camper’s name and recommended dosage. All medication should then be placed in a re-sealable plastic bag with the camper’s name written on the outside. Any notes to the camp Nurse should be inside the bag for their review. This bag should be brought to registration. Campers should not retain their own medication. This is for the safety of the other campers.

A bank for the camper’s spending money is available for most weeks. Please bring the spending money to registration to deposit into the CBC bank. All remaining funds will be available for pickup Saturday morning.

Lost articles can not be mailed or saved. Each year, hundreds of items are left behind. The cost to store and mail these items are such that CBC can not provide these services. Please check your camper’s luggage and the lost-and-found location before leaving the campus.

Mail can be sent to campers at the camp address. Please keep phone calls limited to emergency situations.
